**PAGE 2**

Here's a little more information regarding what is typically expected of an attendee at a Goody's race.

**#1 – Depending on the start time of the races – we are required to be at the track at 7:00 AM – yes, that's right – EARLY morning. (if it is a night race – we generally have to be there by 12:00 pm).**

**#2 – You will be on your feet for roughly 8 hours working. Sometimes it's cold (Atlanta spring race 39°) – sometimes it's hot – (Bristol August race was 100°).**

**#3 – We do get tickets to the races that we work, AND we typically watch the ENTIRE race. Obviously for the Sunday races – depending on the location and travel time back home- we will only take in a brief amount of the race.**

**#4 – Soft sided Coolers are allowed in all the tracks – however, there are certain restrictions on size. I'll send out the websites before the races with information on all that. We typically take in some snacks and water and other essential items. (Sunscreen is a must).**

**#5 – Lunch and snacks are provided at each race by the Goody's crew. Sodas and water as well.**

**#6 - There is no drinking alcoholic beverages or smoking in the Goody's zone.**

**#7 – Depending on which race it is – a van may be obtained for transportation. In certain situations (and home cities of attendees) – there is a slight chance that you may be able to receive some compensation for gas. For example – for the Darlington (SC) race in 2007: there were two other vehicles coming from the eastern side of the state – it was out of their way to require them to come to Greensboro just to catch a van down to SC- so they were given gas money (up to a certain amount). This will be handled on a race to race basis.**

**#8 – We are here to have fun. What happens at the Goody's Zone – stays at the Goody's Zone**
